"Rick Sowash has a Cello Sonata we are in the process of recording," Sam enthusiastically reports, "and that piece will be featured along with Rudy Perrault's *Brother Malcolm* which celebrates the music of Haiti and the inauguration of Barack Obama." Josh is quick to add, "We also discovered that composer Stephen Paulus can take folk songs and give them a fresh sound and are excited to perform a few of those along with a selection or two by Arthur Foote, the first totally American classical composer." Believing that "all music was once new", the duo definitely looks for inspiring, thoughtful music coming from composers in our own era.
