Bayfield Concerts Continue

"Summer (Mostly) Thursdays" - a fresh new series of concerts - offers a broad range of music in a variety of settings around Bayfield, performed by musicians from the Chequamegon Bay area and beyond. The series continues on Thursday, July 1, from 5:00-6:15 pm, at the Bayfield Presbyterian Church, 306 Washington Avenue, Bayfield, WI. Featured will be the Minneapolis/Ashland-based duo **Rio Brio** ("Fiery River").

The musicians of **Rio Brio**, Tony Hauser (guitar) and Betty Braunstein (flute), are known for their rapport, versatility and sparky performances. The standing room only crowd at the duo's last performance in this area was treated to Classical, Flamenco, and Brazilian selections. For July 1, the duo will include a similar mixture of styles including music of Piazzolla, Pixinguinha, Paschoal, Gismonti, Tedeso, and Guiliani. "We also love to include a few selections of 'French Summer Fluff' by Faure or Debussy," says Hauser. Braunstein is quick to add, "And this year we are delighted to bring a few of Tony's own compositions to the performance."
