## NOTES

**Tony Hauser** is the son of two renowned artists, sculptor Alonzo Hauser and modern dance choreographer Nancy McKnight Hauser. Yes! Tony is related to the Hauser family of Hauser's Superior View Farm in Bayfield. Ask Tony to tell you the story.

Tony's concert career spans over thirty years with hundreds of performances in communities and colleges throughout North America. His approach to the guitar defies categorization. Strongly rooted in the classical tradition, his explorations of Spanish flamenco, Latin American, ethnic and new music present the widest variety of performance. He has toured with the legendary jazz guitarist Charlie Byrd and leads "The Brazilnutz", a band specializing in authentic performances of a variety of Brazilian musical styles not often heard in the U.S. His music has been broadcast on NPR and Garrison Keillor's "A Prairie Home Companion." He has also won the MN Music Award for Guitarists and is the founder of the MN Guitar society. Currently he serves on the faculty of the Univ. of St. Thomas in St. Paul, MN.

His discography includes "Circulo Magico" and "Distribution of Flowers" with Brazilian recorder virtuosa Cléa Galhano, and a recording of Russian Gypsy music with the singer, Sergei Pobedinski, entitled "Gentlemen Gypsies". He has released on his own label—Blue Gentian Records, numerous titles including "So Por Amor", a tribute album with the Brasilnutz of the music of Brazilian guitarist-composer, Baden Powell, two solo discs entitled "Hauling it All" and "The Living Room Tapes", and all flamenco disc with guest artists, guitarist Pedro Cortes and flamenco singer Jesus Montoya entitled "Un Ratito con Tio Tony".

**Betty Braunstein** is a tenured member of the Duluth Superior Symphony Orchestra and a chamber music recitalist. She also performs with 6AroundOne, a world music band fluent in Latin and Celtic styles. Betty and teaches students of all ages and ability in both the Twin Ports community and at her home in Ashland, Wisconsin. She received her Bachelor of Music degree in Performance and Music Therapy from the University of the Pacific after studies at the University of California, Los Angeles. Her Masters degree in Music Performance was earned at the University of Minnesota, Twin Cities, where she studied with Julia Bogorad.

Betty considers herself as one of the many blades of grass in the field of freelance flutists.
