PROGRAM NOTES

Bob Lindell began his organ studies in college and has been playing ever since. He has performed at many churches including Elim Lutheran Church (Duluth) for 6 years. Bob was one of the founders of *A Denfeld Organ Project* (ADOPT), which restored the 1900's Kilgen pipe organ housed in the Denfeld High School Auditorium (Duluth). Since the restoration, he has played for Awards and Graduation Ceremonies in its historic setting. Bob remains interested in restoration, but his first love is playing for worship services and leading people in worship. He is one of the organists at Bayfield Presbyterian Church and helped with the installation of this wonderful instrument.

Myra Bliss has a BA in music from Northland College and an MBA from Monmouth University, West Long Branch NJ. She taught music, both instrumental and vocal, in several states during her husband's US Army service. Myra has been a choir director/organist at several military chapels as well as churches in New Jersey. After retiring from teaching and moving to Ashland, she became the accompanist for the *Rittenhouse Singers* (Bayfield) and the *Lumberjack Chorus* (Northland College). She sings in the *Chequamegon Area Choir* and directs the hand bell choir at the First Covenant Church (Ashland). Myra has two adult children and one grandchild.
